

Jeffco Articulation Area Student Achievement Results

Introduction

- Since we moved from Calgary to Jeffco in 2010, the district has always been quite stingy when it comes to presenting comprehensive school-by-school, and articulation area by articulation area analyses of student achievement performance
- Given that educating children is supposed to be a school district's core competence, this has never made sense to me. Refusing to squarely face bad news does not help an organization to improve its performance
- With Jeffco embarking on a process that will result in the closure and consolidation of multiple schools, I believe it is critical that the community has a detailed picture of their academic results

Notes on the Data We Use

- Achievement data comes from publicly available 2019 CMAS results
 - **Achievement Proficiency** is an absolute measure of a student's performance against an absolute standard. In the tables, we show the number and percent of students who met or exceeded the minimum score for proficiency in English Language Arts and Math
 - We also provide the percent of students at each high school who met the College and Career Ready standard on the grade 11 SAT for both Evidence Based Reading and Writing and for Math
 - In Colorado, **Achievement Growth** is a relative measure of a student's performance compared to other students who has the same proficiency score the previous year. It is measured as a percentile. A student whose growth was in the 50th percentile would be right in the middle of the pack.
 - For groups of students, growth is measured using the "Median Growth Percentile", which is the growth percentile for the student whose score is in the middle of the group

Notes on the Data We Use (cont'd)

- Too many people in Colorado believe that the 50th growth percentile represents a normal year of academic growth. This is incorrect.
 - There are plenty of examples of schools with Median Growth Percentiles above 50% where the percent of students meeting or exceeding the cut score for proficiency actually declined
 - Why? Each year, the cut score required to score at or above proficient increases as students move from grade to grade
 - Depending on the composition of a group of students, the median increase in their achievement proficiency score can differ, even when both groups have the same Median Growth Percentile
- Because MGPs can significantly vary from year to year because of the changing mix of students in a school, we average 3 years of MGPs to get a more stable measure of relative student achievement growth

Notes on the Data We Use (cont'd)

- The number of pupils in each school comes from Colorado Department of Education Data
- Data for teachers who use more than 10 personal and sick days comes from the Civil Rights Division of the US Department of Education
 - Their research shows that a teacher who is chronically absent for more than 10 days has a significant negative impact on student achievement
 - This data is collected every two years, but reported with a three year lag. The data we show are from 2017. The data collected in 2019 will be published later this year. That said, because of the stability of many (but not all) school cultures over time, teacher absentee rates tend not to change very much
 - For example, Jeffco's overall teacher chronic absence rates were 25.7% (2011); 29.8% (2013); 22.3% (2015); and 24.5% (2017)
 - Unfortunately, Jeffco does not publicly report annual teacher absence data by school
